Basketball Program Rules

1. The Kirtland Youth Association (KYA) Winter Basketball Program will be administered by a Basketball Committee appointed by the KYA Board of Directors.
2. The KYA Board of Directors will appoint a Basketball Commissioner who is responsible for administering the program according to the rules and regulations established by the KYA Board of Directors.
3. The Commissioner's duties will include but not limited to scheduling the gyms for practices and games, setting up the practice and game schedules, supervising the coaches, games, and the game officials and workers, assist the Basketball Committee with the preseason draft, and other duties as assigned by the Basketball Committee.
4. The Commissioner will set up practice times, gym locations, game schedules, and game workers and officials. These are the only times and locations authorized by the Kirtland Youth Association for practices and games. Only KYA issued "T – Shirts" will be allowed as uniforms for games. Teams wearing other types of uniforms will not be allowed to play and will forfeit that game.
5. The Basketball Committee will accept applications for volunteer coaches and officials. Game officials, scorers, and timers for all league games will be compensated for their services. All volunteers must be approved by the Basketball Committee. The Basketball Committee will establish the guidelines for selection of volunteers to fill the various volunteer positions.
6. The number of coaches needed for the program will be determined by the Committee depending on the number of participants registered.
7. The Basketball Program is open to boys and girls in grades 2 through 8. Participants will be placed on a team through a draft system setup by the Basketball Committee. The Basketball Committee reserves the right to establish the guidelines for the draft and setting up of teams.
8. Parents will fill out a registration form for their child/children complete with all information ask for on the registration form. Parents are ask to rate their child or children's basketball skills in passing, dribbling, shooting, and game experience on the following scale: (5) Very Proficient, (4) Proficient, (3) Somewhat Proficient, (2) Limited Proficiency, and (1) Beginner. The Basketball Committee reserves the right to review the ratings and make changes the Committee feels is needed.
9. Participants will be assessed a registration fee of \$40.00 if they are registered and their fee is paid by the closing date for registration (November 15, 2007). Participants who register after the closing date for registration will pay a fee of \$60.00. Participants whose fee is not paid by the day of the draft will not be placed

in the draft. Once the draft is conducted there will be no refund of a player's registration fee. Players dismissed from the program for disciplinary reasons will not get a refund of their registration fee.

10. Seventh and eighth grade girls playing on the middle school basketball teams must register for KYA basketball within five (5) days after the completion of the eighth grade season. These players will be placed in a "supplemental draft" at the completion of their registration period. Players who do not register within the five (5) day period will not be allowed to participate in the KYA program.
11. Seventh and eighth grade boys will register during the regular registration period and will be placed in the "regular draft." Boys registered for KYA basketball who make the middle school teams will be refunded their registration fee.
12. Girls or boys who are dismissed from the middle school basketball programs for disciplinary reasons will not be allowed to participate in the KYA Basketball Program.
13. Participants will be rated by the Committee and ranked for the draft. Head coaches will be allowed to have his/her child/children on the team that they coach. Head coaches' children will not be placed in the draft. All other participants will be placed in the draft. Only the head coaches, the Commissioner, and Basketball Committee members will be allowed in the draft.
14. The draft to be conducted on Tuesday, November 20th in the KYA facility.
15. If the head coach of a team desires an assistant coach, the assistant coach will have to come from a parent of one of his/her drafted players or from an individual who does not have a child in the program.
16. Once the draft has been conducted, the movement of players from one team to another will not be allowed without the permission of the Basketball Committee.
17. Coaches or players found to be in violation of any of the above rules and regulations will be dismissed from the program.

These rules and regulations were adopted by the KYA Board of Directors on October 30, 2007.
